BIRDHOUSE SPECIFICATIONS:

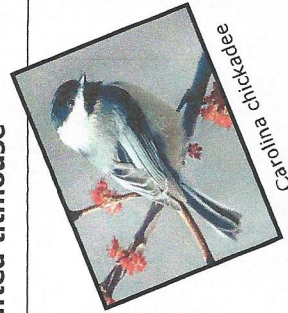
Birdhouse front, back, and sides are 1" western cedar; roof is 1" white pine. Fasteners are galvanized nails, front opens for easy yearly cleaning with a galvanized "L" hook. These birdhouses are built to last!

Nest boxes can be installed on any metal post or electrical conduit, readily available at box stores or local hardware stores.

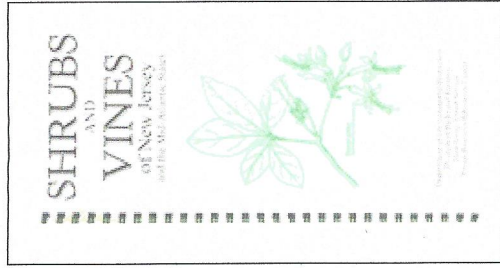
