

## **COVID-19 Guidelines for Outdoor Meetings On and Off UUCSJS Grounds**

1. Prior to meeting, congregants should complete the Daily Health Pledge to ensure safety of themselves and others
2. Congregants should not attend who are on the New Jersey 14 day quarantine travel advisory list, or who have had known close contact with any individual who has COVID 19
3. Persons should not attend with symptoms such as fever or chills, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, and diarrhea (see Daily Health Pledge).
3. Persons attending a meeting will wear masks (see face mask education on our website) and bring their own chairs. Individuals can remove their masks once seated but should put their masks back on prior to standing to leave.
- 4.. Persons should maintain a distance of 6 feet apart when not wearing masks; persons in family or household living groups may be allowed to maintain distance of less than 6 feet.
4. No food or drink sharing will be permitted.
5. No singing will be permitted.
6. Sanitizer, extra masks, and insect spray will be available upon request.
7. Off grounds meetings will be held in the vicinity of a well-maintained porta potty for attendee use. Those attending meetings at the UUCSJS location will have access to the building restrooms. Only one person at a time may be allowed to enter the building to use the restroom (except for any person requiring assistance or a child with a parent/caregiver).. Sanitizer will be available for use upon entry. It is advised that everyone allow 5 minutes in between use of the indoor restroom.
